## Result: Hurley won by 37 runs.

Hurley ended the season on a high with a victory, away to ex-Hurley player Nally Fernando's Hampton Hill.

Having won the toss the skipper decided to make a brave decision and send in his Hurley old timers to open the batting, Dave Walton and Phil Ridgeway. This is not a combination often seen unless as a bowling duo. The first three over's were going well for the opposition, when all of a sudden Dave Walton decided that he was going to start scoring with two very well placed edges that saw him instantly out-score Phil Ridgeway. This aggressive batting from Dave did not last long and he departed for a well played 13. At this stage the opposition thought that the first wicket was going to be the start of many, but had not encountered on Phil Ridgeway finding form with the bat, along with Mark Allen, who looked very good but could do nothing but find the fielder. After a good partnership of 90, Mark was finally run out for 17. Phil continued his onslaught of the opposition, with another good batting partner in Pat Hinnell (18), the pair putting on another good partnership. Once Phil had

reached 110\* he had to retire hurt, but that did not stop the scoring as Parvinder Hunjan (35 n.o.) and Pat managed to get the visitors up to a respectable total of 234 after 35 over's.

Not to be outdone by the batsmen, the bowling force of Sam Draper 1-34 and Darryn Wright were called into the attack to start Hurley's defence. Draper was first to attack with a well placed full toss on the stumps which saw Harris swing and miss. Second was Wright with a well worked over, tying Mitchell in knots before eventually removing his off stump.

Hunjan was next to strike, also bowling out A. Butt (22) who looked to be getting his team on the way to recovery. Wermington (81) and D. Coates (22) were getting their team back in the game and with lack of success from the other bowlers were looking rather comfortable. This was until the Skipper decided to pull his opener back in and with great results. Wright took the off stump of Wermington in his first return over, and then followed in the next over by taking the off stump of Coates. In Wright's final over he took a further two wickets to give him his first five wicket haul for Hurley after five years at the club. By this time the opposition were well and truly out of the race and further wickets from Phil Ridgeway (1-11) and Mike Cole (1-23) wrapped up the victory as the hosts finished on 197-9.
