Tight opening overs from Jerry Smith and Simon Harrison saw only 11 runs conceded off the first 16 balls. A huge six from Dean Nye (14*) was the only highlight of the innings as Hurley finished their 5 overs on 37 for 3.

The Wargrave reply started badly with Json Noah bowled first ball by Osama Tariq. This proved to be only a minor setback as Simon French and Neil Robinson proceded to take 27 runs off the remaining 7 balls of the over. Shoaib Kayani also started well, beating Robinson outside off stump, but again this was only a temporary respite as the remaing runs were knocked off inside the second over to send Wargrave through to face Braywood in the next round.
